What is the Corridor Plan

- The Corridor Plan is a guiding document for the overall design of the Highway Corridor. It includes:
 - An overall goal
 - An assessment of current conditions
 - A traffic analysis
 - Gateways
 - Signage and Way finding
 - Corridor Design and Cross Sections
 - Possible Access Management Plan

What has been done so far?

Four Public Visioning Meetings in 2011

- Sidewalks
- Bike lanes
- Landscaping
- Better turn lanes
- Medians at crosswalks for pedestrian refuge
- Intersection improvements



- Public Input Design Meetings 2012
- Town Staff has met with CDOT officials
- The Town has submitted a request for Federal Transportation Enhancement Funding for improvements to the Highway beginning in 2014




What is the Long Term Goal

"The installation of highway improvements that have the support of the community that address safety, multimodal transportation, economic vitality, and the beautification of the corridor." -Buena Vista Planning and Zoning Commission

Phase 1: Crosswalk Enhancement Improvements

- New illuminated pedestrian crossing signage and ADA ramps at the existing crosswalks located along the corridor
- Addresses a major safety concern along the highway in 2011



Phase 2: Highway Corridor Plan

- Public Meetings through June for the preliminary design of the highway
- Meetings with individual property owners and community organizations
- Meetings with CDOT officials
- CDOT approval in November with the Completion of a traffic study
- Approval of Plan by P&Z and Board of Trustees December 2012

Phase 3: Traffic Study and Access Management Plan

- A complete traffic study must be done to determine if the selected design can be implemented along the Highway
- This will be occurring this year

Phase 4: Surveying/Engineering

- The survey will determine the exact location of CDOT ROW, and will highlight areas where public/private partnerships may need to be established for easements or dedication for extra ROW
- The design of the highway will be engineered and ready for construction by the end of 2013
- This will be when business owners know what exactly is proposed in front of their properties

Phase 5: Construction of Highway Improvements

- This phase would be carried out from 2014 2018
- This is the construction of improvements on the ground
- Construction will be phased to allow businesses to remain open for business during construction.

What happened last time?

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- Discussed existing conditions. Identified:
 - Dangerous/unsafe conditions
 - Important crossing points
 - Places that generate high traffic
 - Other important nodes along highway
- Constructed different highway designs using different highway "pieces"



What did we come up with?


- The designs and comments led staff to create five designs.
- The designs borrow various elements from the ideas from the previous meeting.
- Keep in mind that these are design concepts:
 - Nothing is final
 - They are to scale, but they are not engineer









New Access and Sidewalks




Pedestrian Refuge

Large Median with Bike Lanes




Table Discussion
